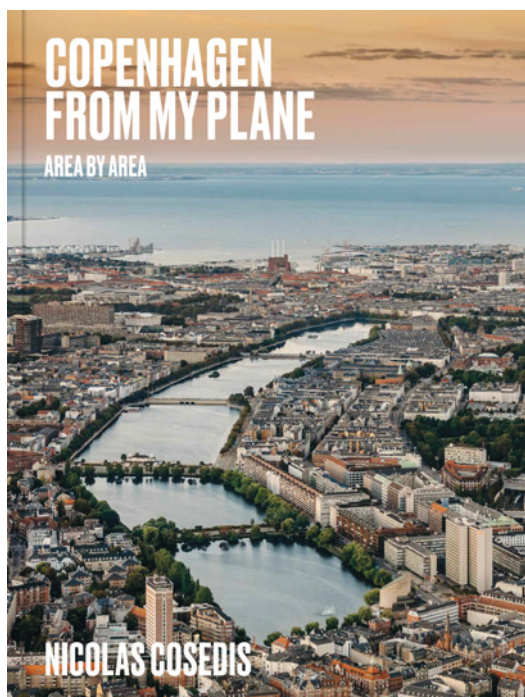

A photographic declaration of love for Copenhagen

Having received great acclaim for both previous releases and on social media, Nicolas Cosedis' captivating aerial photos of Copenhagen are now launched in a new and smaller book.

Copenhagen from My Plane is divided into sections with the different areas of Copenhagen – from the city centre to Østerbro, Nørrebro and Vesterbro, Frederiksberg, Islands Brygge and Christianshavn, and with excursions to the suburbs of Copenhagen: Nærum, Dragør, Brøndby, and Charlottenlund. This way, the photos become even more accessible – especially to people who are visiting the city for the first time. With this backpack-sized book, tourists, and locals alike can explore the narrow streets, grand palaces, and modern architecture of Copenhagen, while simultaneously having the perspective of the city from between 1,200 and 12,000 feet up in the air.

Cosedis has been photographing Copenhagen from above for many years. *Copenhagen from My Plane* contains a selection of his best photographs. Hovering in a plane high above the city's roofs, he shows us a Copenhagen that otherwise only the birds see, opening the city in a completely new way for both locals and tourists.

When Cosedis goes on a shoot, he has a professional pilot by his side so that he can concentrate on pointing the camera at his subject of choice. Although the experienced aerial photographer does not have his hand on the control stick, he still directs the plane with rehearsed commands to the pilot. With a speed of up to 60 meters per second, the two must

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know each other well to catch the perfect angle. “The collaboration takes place on an almost telepathic level, where the pilot must know what I am thinking. When I want him to turn the plane – not 30, but 35 degrees – so I can get the perfect shot, he knows exactly what I mean,” Nicolas Cosedis says.

About the author and photographer

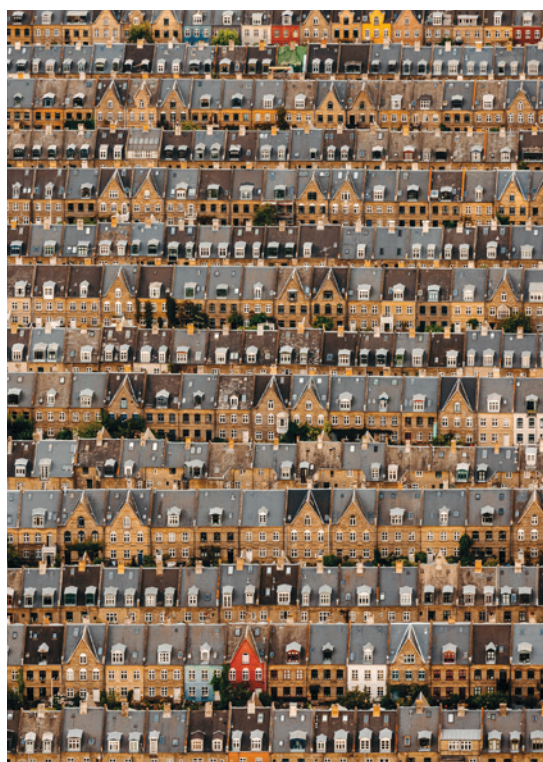
